## Meet Matilda – My 1926 Chevrolet Buckboard

Hi, my name is Lisette Santin, and I am the proud owner of Matilda, a 1926 Chevrolet Buckboard.

My connection with Matilda goes back a very long way. Dad, Len, purchased her from a family friend out near Kadina when I was about eight years old. At the time, Matilda's working days were long behind her, and she was being used as a chook pen by the previous owner.

For many years after Dad brought her home, Matilda sat under a lean-to-shed and became my very own cubby house. Like any young girl with a vivid imagination, I thought she looked especially beautiful covered in hand-painted daisies!

Around 1970, Dad decided it was time to bring Matilda back to life. He undertook the restoration himself, completing all of the timber work, metal work and painting with great care and dedication. It was truly a labor of love.

When Dad passed away ten years ago, I was fortunate enough to inherit Matilda. Owning her means far more than simply having an old car; she is a treasured family heirloom filled with memories of my childhood and of Dad's passion and craftsmanship.

Since taking ownership, I have had the engine rebuilt by Mike Stewart from West Torrens Dyno. Other than that, Matilda remains very much as Dad restored her all those years ago.

Of course, as anyone who owns a vintage vehicle knows, there are always a few little issues that need attention. Thankfully, with the help of Adam Jones, we managed to sort them out. Adam also patiently taught me how to drive Matilda—a skill that is definitely an art form all of its own!

Now I am eagerly looking forward to the warmer weather so I can get Matilda out on more club runs and enjoy everything that vintage motoring has to offer.

Every time I climb behind the wheel, I am reminded of Dad and the countless hours he spent restoring her. I know that wherever the road takes me, Dad will always be right there by my side.

Matilda may be 100 years old, but she remains a treasured part of our family's story—and I look forward to creating many more memories with her in the years ahead.



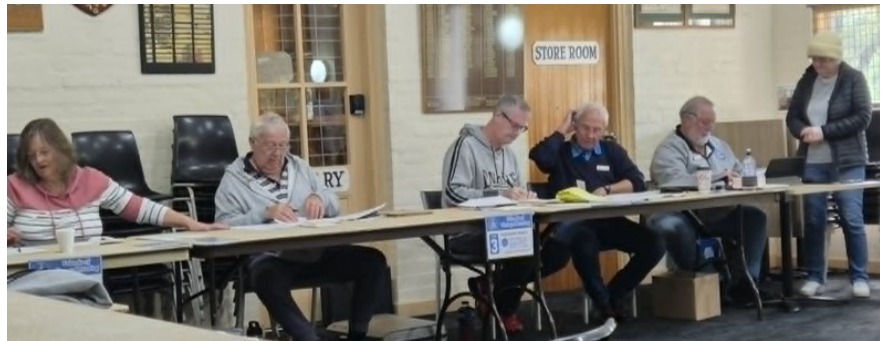
